Fraud Policy

Applies to any fraud, or suspected fraud, involving employees as well as board members, advisory councils, grantees, consultants, vendors, or contractors.

•How often should employees complete the 'Conflict of Interest' form?




Conflict of Interest

- NOTE: Board has asked EPF to perform random checks of 'Conflict of Interest forms'

- Incomplete or no procurement bids (accusations of favoritism/kickbacks)
- •Under advertised RFP/Grant Competitions (accusations of favoritism/kickbacks)
- Not following proposal receipt/review award policies.
